DECISION No. 1 / 2001
of the Slovak Republic-Turkey Joint Committee on the Temporary Compensation
for Live Bovine Animals mentioned in Annex B Protocol 2

Having regard to the difficulties in the Republic of Turkey for issuing control certificates for live bovine animals and to the fact that the concessions on live bovine animals mentioned in Annex B of Protocol 2 of the Free Trade Agreement between the Slovak Republic and the Republic of Turkey (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement") could not be applied in due time;

Having regard to the need to compensate the losses of the Slovak Republic arising from the inapplication of concessions granted by the Republic of Turkey for

live bovine animals originating in Slovakia in accordance with the provisions of Annex B of Protocol 2 of the Agreement;

The Joint Committee has decided as follows:

Article 1

The Turkish Party shall temporarily open on imports from the Slovak Republic new and additional tariff quotas to be applied as indicated below:

The Slovak Republic accepts the above-detailed compensation for the losses incurred in 2000 and 2001.

Article 2

If difficulties in importation of live bovine animals continue after 2001, the new and additional quotas shall be valid in the year concerned with half of the quantities indicated for each product specified in the Article 1.

Article 3

The tariff quotas of 400 tons for live bovine animals

under CN Codes of 0102.90.05, 0102.90.21-29 and 0102.90.41-49 originating in the Slovak Republic have been temporarily suspended starting from entry into force of this Decision.

Article 4

This Decision shall enter into force on the date of a receipt of the latter diplomatic note confirming the approval by the Government of the respective Party, not later than 1 July 2001.
